

## **Withnell Amateur Swimming Club Training Policy**

### **What is this about?**

Withnell Amateur Swimming Club (WASC) rely on many unpaid helpers to run the club for the community. WASC are committed to the training of its volunteer coaching and life saving supporters, and has done this for many years. Based on this experience it has been decided to document and formalise the training policy for WASC.

### **What do I do?**

For any training undertaken, a WASC Training Request Form must be completed by the person to receive the training (the 'Receiver') and signed by a committee member (the 'Sponsor'). This form will confirm to the Receiver the terms and conditions under which training will be funded by WASC.

The request will be considered by the WASC committee at the next convenient meeting. A decision to support training will be based on the Receiver's responsibility, maturity, swimming ability and commitment to the club. The decision of the committee will be communicated to the Receiver in writing, with reasons for the decision.

### **What training is supported by WASC?**

<u>Training</u>	<u>Age</u>	<u>Funding</u>	<u>Commitment</u>
Life Saving	16+	50%	12 sessions in first year
Level 1 Coaching	18+	100%	12 sessions in first year
Level 2 Coaching	18+	100%	12 sessions in first year

If the Receiver is unable to fulfil the club commitment after being trained, then the club reserves the right to recover some or all of cost of the training from that him/her.
